



ABERDEEN LADIES SCOTTISH OPEN 2010
ARCHERFIELD LINKS WEDNESDAY 18 – FRIDAY 20 AUGUST.

The Ladies Scottish Open, presented by EventScotland, with Aberdeen Asset Management as its title sponsor, will make a welcome return to the Ladies European Tour in August 2010. The venue is the world renowned Archerfield Links in East Lothian. The tournament which runs from Wednesday 18th – Friday 20th August boasts a unique and innovative format in the guise of a Pro-am tournament. The format of the tournament will be limited to 60 of the top Lady Professionals playing with a celebrity / amateur.

Alec Littlejohn, George Boag, and Lynn Mitchell have once again been asked to assemble a team of volunteers to undertake a wide range of duties at this tournament. We organised these duties on the two previous occasions when the Ladies Scottish Open was held at The Carrick on Loch Lomond in 2007 and 2008.

To cover the Tournament we require a team of volunteers to undertake the following duties:

- a) **Greenside Scorers** Positioned at every third green exit, to record the player and team scores and relay them back to Score Control. This information is radioed to the various scoreboards positioned around the course. There will be no walking scorers, except possibly for the last 4-6 matches on Friday the final day of the tournament.
- b) **Leader boards.** There will be two volunteer operators working on each leader board. The leader boards will record the best Pro at the top and best team half way down to incorporate both scores.
- c) **Main Score board.** There will be 4/5 operators working on the main board.

Approximately 60 will be required to operate this system on a rota basis. (2 Shifts am & pm)

- d) **Marshals** at the moment we envisage operating a 4 zone system with a mixture of a few static marshals and **ball spotters** but mainly travelling marshals. The travelling teams of two marshals accompanying a playing group round their allocated zone handing over to a team from the following zone.

Between 16 and 20 marshals will be required for each zone.

We will require volunteers to be on a duty rota on each of the tournament days and all to attend a briefing session on Sunday 15th August when tickets and uniforms will also be distributed.

Scorers will be given instruction on scoring and use of radios etc. and the marshals on their various duties.

We will make every effort to ensure that this event is successful and becomes a permanent fixture on the Ladies Professional Tour.
